#### April 25, 2023 Organizational Meeting

### School Board Representative to Serve as Delegate At the CESA Annual Convention

Cooperative Educational Service Agencies (CESAs) were created by the Wisconsin legislature more than 50 years ago to serve as a link between school districts and between school districts and the state. There are twelve CESAs across the state.

Located in Southeastern Wisconsin, CESA #1 is governed by an 11 member Board of Control, comprised of elected school board members from the six county region. In addition, the Agency receives guidance from its Professional Advisory Committee, which is open to the superintendents from all 45 member districts.

The vision of CESA #1 is to be a regional catalyst that enables districts to create their future by taking action now. CESA #1's mission is to provide high quality, cost effective programs and services that are responsive to the dynamic needs of their members, clients and the students they serve.

Kenosha Unified School District is a member of CESA #1. The Superintendent of Schools serves as a member of the Professional Advisory Committee (PAC). As a member district, the Board of Education may appoint a board member to serve as its representative at the CESA convention scheduled for May 16, 2023.

Additionally, there is a vacancy on the CESA #1 Board of Control for Group E of which Kenosha Unified School District is a member. Should the Board of Education wish to seek a three-year term on the Board of Control at the May 16 election, the District is to inform CESA #1 as soon as possible.

#### Recommendation

It is recommended that the School Board appoint a representative to participate at the CESA #1 annual convention in Pewaukee, Wisconsin on May 16, 2023. It is also recommended that if the Board wishes to seek a position on the CESA #1 Board of Control, it determine its candidate.

Section 116.02, Wis. Stats., in its entirety, reads as follows:

116.02 Board of control; membership (1)(a) Each agency shall be governed by a board of control composed of members of school boards oschool districts within the agency. Annually on or after the 4th Monday in April, the school board of each school district in the agency shall appoint one of its members as its representative for the purpose of determining the composition of the board of control. For the purpose of determining membership on the board of control, a school district operating elementary grades only and lying in more than one union high school district shall be considered part of the union high school territory in which the major portion of its equalized valuation lies. The board of control shall hold an annual organizational meeting on or after the 2nd Monday in May. No annual organizational meeting may be held after the 2nd Monday in August.

(c) The state superintendent **b**all cause to convene annually on the day that the board of control holds its annual organizational meeting under par. (a) a convention composed of the representative from each school board in the agency. There shall be no more than one representative from each union high school district. The convention may direct the board of control to determine a different date for the annual organizational meeting.

(2) The annual convention shall establish bylaws for governing the agency, including bylaws for all of the following:

(a) Subject to sub.(1)(a), setting the date of the annual convention and establishing procedures for calling a special meeting.

(b) Providing for regular meetings of the board of control.

(c) Establishing an initial plan of representation for the agency and specifying how the plan may be amended.

(d) Specifying the number of members on the board of control.

(e) Specifying what constitutes a vacancy on the board of control and establishing procedures for filling a vacancy on the board ocontrol.

(f) Specifying the officers on the board of control, establishing procedures for choosing those officers, specifying their terms of office and their duties and establishing procedures for removing them from office.

(g) Providing for the establishment offiscal control, responsibility and accountability requirements.

(h) Designating a public depository.
